SCTA TRAIL USE POLICY

Approved 02-19-2020

Our direct access points to the BSFNRRA provide reciprocal entry and exit to the Park for horseback riders and hikers. To minimize problems/confusion, we strive to align the use of the trails/trail heads owned and or maintained by the SCTA as closely as possible with those of the adjacent Big South Fork River and Recreational Area safety zones and Tennessee Law.

DOGS:

Dogs must be restrained on a 6 foot leash.

Allowing dogs to run at large (tramming) while on horseback is prohibited.

FIREARMS:

With a valid firearms carry permit recognized by the state of Tennessee, pistols may be carried on foot or on horseback.

Rifles/long guns must be unloaded while on horseback.

No Hunting/shooting of firearms on trails or while on horseback.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES, BICYCLES, CARTS/WAGONS:

Motorized Vehicles: (such as trucks/tractors/ATV's/golf carts, dirt bikes etc.) are not allowed on the trails, except for authorized maintenance and emergencies.

Bicycles are not allowed on the trails.

With the appropriate signage as required by the state, equine drawn carts and wagons may be driven on roads in TN. However, as our trails are not wide enough for safe passage or turnaround, equine drawn carts/wagons are not allowed on the trails.

TRAIL MAINTENANCE:

"Trail Work Ahead" signs will be posted whenever possible to alert users of equipment usage and detours.
