B E A R S

The bears are back! There have been at least 4 sightings in Spruce Creek—two on Evergreen and two on Deer Haven Trail. And 2 of these were “up close and personal” as in at the front door!

Due to the lack of acorns this year and the late arrival of spring, the bears are hungry and looking for food. So PLEASE—make your home bear UNFRIENDLY!

Do not leave pet food out on the porches or in the yard. Pick up trash (garbage) and place it in a closed container. Take your trash to the dump weekly (or more often if you can). Do not put bird feeders up by the house. Hang them away from the house high up off the ground—the best thing is not to have any at all. Keep horse feed in a closed container and behind a closed door, And don't forget the BBQ grill. Keep it clean and covered. These are the things that will attract the bears attention the fastest. If we all do our part, then Mr/Ms Bear will just pass on through.

These bears don't seem to be afraid of people and that is a problem. Don't try to approach them. Use loud noises—air horns, banging pots and pans, anything that will startle the bear and encourage him to move on.

Being knowledgeable is being prepared.

New Signs For Spruce Creek Trails

The SCTA is working to have new directional signs erected on our trail system within Spruce Creek. Dave Duchon has volunteered to make the signs and they will be installed on posts at the appropriate intersections. We have a lot of riders from other areas that seem to get lost (not to mention some of the locals). Initially we will have 9 posts that will have a total of 40 signs to help riders get to their desired destination.

There will be an SCTA workday announced when we are ready for the posts/signs to be installed.

Workday at the Pavilion

The picnic tables at the pavilion are in serious need of cleaning and new varnish. Wednesday, June 19th at 8am will be a workday to power-wash the tables and get them ready for a new coat of varnish (which will be another workday, possibly after July 4th)

Some general clean-up of the pavilion will also be done at this time.

Trail Work

There have been numerous complaints about the Tee Pee trail at the creek crossing. The board will be looking into correcting the problem. We will be talking to Ricky Rains to come up with the best way to resolve the situation.

Proctor Ridge Trail still needs some additional water bars put in place and also the park service has interlocking bricks which need to be installed at the creek crossing— another workday project coming up in the future.

The trail that runs alongside of Jaime Whittaker's place is plagued with underground springs. We are trying to come up with a good way to make the trail safer and to find a more permanent way to fix the muddy spots.
