Trail Updates

Trail maintenance is an ongoing, ever-needed job for SCTA. The rock job on Tee Pee Loop seems to have weathered the winter well. A few of the trails between houses need some minor work. We have decided to close the Crockett Creek trail and route traffic on the road between Crockett Creek and Spruce Creek Road. The sink holes are a moving target on that trail that follows the creek. Until we find a better solution ("Slabwood" & tile road possibly) we've decided play on the safe side. We will also be putting a motorized-vehicle barricade at the Tanglewood / Spruce Creek entrance, as part of the Neighborhood Watch effort. Horses, of course, will be able to pass through. We will be purchasing and mounting Tennessee Equine disclaimer and other appropriate signage for the trails as well. Outside groups that want to have organized rides using our trails will now be required to use the Liability Waiver we provide.

Pavilion Work Day is Monday May 18th, to open and clean the pavilion. We'll need some large ladders to get up in the roofing to pull down loose insulation. Gloves, safety glasses and work clothes recommended. Also, bring your ATV's as we'll do a litter run on the local trails.
