Tom Pickard and Jan Ballard have been "sprucing" up the Spruce Creek Pavilion by sanding and staining the tables. There's more "light" maintenance to be done there, so contact Jan if you'd like to volunteer.

We're looking into putting our trail map on permanent signs, with a "You Are Here" indicator. That should help visitors find their way through and back to their starting spots.

During the Board Meeting it was discussed and agreed upon to have "permanent" work days established every week, probably on Tuesdays. Signs will be posted and out-of-neighborhood riders should be aware that they MAY encounter 4x4's or tractors on work detail those days.
