1	04-24-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Evergreen Trail Head/Taft Story Road to Indian Rocks Road needs grading (by Keith Holly property)	Ricky Rains	Ricky Rains, Ivan Whitehead, and Danny Hatcher all worked on this to improve drainage. <b>Note: Due to terrain and drainage, this piece of trail will continue to require on-going maintenance.</b> <b>See item #7</b>
2	05-24-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Deep ditch on Spruce Creek Dr/Spruce Creek Trail probably needs tile/drain pipe work and rock (Dale Orr property – by Bonnie Glaser)	Ricky Rains and Danny Hatcher	Danny put in drain, still working on rock and drainage
3	05-24-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Trail that runs along Jaime Whiteaker property has several large areas holding water/sink holes/springs	Danny Hatcher	Danny graded and added rock in numerous places which has provided significant improvement. <b>Note: There are several springs which will probably continue to cause holes and drainage problems.</b>
4	05-24-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Wildcat Den – the step down area repaired last year is starting to wash out (Sloan land)	Danny Hatcher	Danny graded/cleared and repaired washout and drainage. <b>Note: As this step down area is steep and prone to washout, it will need to be monitored for deterioration/wear and tear as the trail season progresses.</b>
5	05-24-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Proctor Ridge Trail has several large areas that are holding water-deteriorating due to heavy horse useage and vehicle traffic back to the Gernt leased land	Danny Hatcher will look at it – may need grading and rock	Some work was done in June. Laurie will walk it next week

6	06-12-2010	<b>Open</b>	Evergreen Trail – behind Keith Holly property-needs additional drainpipe or other work. If the trail could be relocated, perhaps this would improve the on-going problem.	Danny Hatcher will talk to Keith.	Keith said he would buy the tile-Danny will ask him about relocating part of the trail to improve overall drainage.
7	06-12-2010	<b>Open</b>	Proctor Ridge Trail step down area by the creek has severe washout areas. (this land belongs to the Park Service)	Ricky Rains called Wallace from the Park Svc to see if they would be willing to work on it, or help us work on it	We need to continue to follow up with the Park Service who should fix it.
8	06-12-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Trail Head Lane – trail to the Cumberland Trail Head may need cross ties/water turn back work. (borders Ned Helms property-on land owned by Robert Livingston)	Ned will ask Robert if he will help to repair and should coordinate with Danny Hatcher	Most of the work was done by a “mystery person” on a small red tractor. Ned will finish off by dragging/racking.
9	08-13-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Tom Pickard scraped/started some work on Spruce Creek Trail on Spruce Creek Dr. near intersection of Evergreen	Danny Hatcher	Danny did some work to correct and spread straw to help the footing. He needs to check after we have some rain for further grading and drainage.
10	08-13-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Walking Horse Lane somewhat washed out where the horse trail crosses the road	Danny Hatcher	Tom Pickard used rock for fill and fixed it. <b>This is another area that will probably need maintenance attention several times per year</b>
11	08-16-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Trail to Cumberland Trail Head (Robert Livingston owns the land) has a large pine tree across the trail	Needs chain saw to remove per Ned	Ricky and others removed

12	09-2010	<b>Complete</b>	Trail to the Cumberland Trail Head–large washed out area behind the Parson’s vacant lot – on Indian Rock Rd	Worked on it in October It is rideable with ATV or horse back	May want to go back and look at it in the spring to assess again.
13	09-2010	<b>Open</b>	There are cross ties on the trail to Cumberland Trail – were just pushed to the side in the woods	Still there in November	Need a 4 wheel drive truck/equipment to get them back to the pavilion
14	09-2010	<b>Open</b>	Probably need 2 water turn backs on the trails behind the Vaughn’s property on Spruce Cr. Trail to avoid continued washouts	Worked on in October and it is better-but may need a few more	Much improved. <b>This is another area which may need continued monitoring</b>
15	09-2010	<b>Open</b>	Wildcat Den trail-severe drop off in several places is washing out again, plus area down to the creek is washed out/alternate path has roots sticking out. Note: The trail goes across a tract of land owned by the Sloan family which is not part of Spruce Creek.	Sharon and Dino (works for Danny) installed 4 cross tie step downs at the first big drop off which did help. Sharon, Ricky, Bev, Pete, and Laurie walked it again 11-22-10 as part of Board meeting.	Note: the Ridge Top trail folks are willing to help and have worked on the other side going out of the creek.  Ricky will talk to Wallace (care taker) to see if they might allow us to build some switch backs.  Another alternative may be to use sackrette to build walls/more secure step downs.
